

Overview

Healthcare risk management is one of the most needed and yet neglected in majority of healthcare institutions. The current pandemic has highlighted the need for strategic approach to understand and implement Healthcare Risk Management.

Complexity of potential risks in healthcare organizations require a logical framework for identifying, evaluating and responding to risks. 




