The brand "Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences", under Dr. Bhaskar Rao's aegis began its journey in 2004 with a 300 bed hospital on par with the then established hospitals of Hyderabad in professional excellence, the state of art technology and infrastructure facilities. Involving Patients in Safe Healthcare



According to WHO, 1 in 10 are harmed during hospitalization and 4 in 10 patients are harmed in outpatient health care. At least 50% of this harm can be prevented. Commonly medical harm can occur with missed or wrong diagnosis, medication errors, surgical procedures, and infections. Errors also happen when a patient moves from her physician to a hospital, back to home care.

Patient safety and quality care is the foremost goal of healthcare providers. Many hospitals are putting in robust processes using technology to eliminate errors, extensive trainings on safety and focusing on clinical excellence.

However, patients and caregivers do not take an active part in their own safety. Involving patients in their healthcare journey can have a significant impact in reducing avoidable harm. An alert and well-informed patient can make the job of healthcare provider more effective. Their feedback on avoidable harm or near miss will help in taking corrective action.

Patients for Patient Safety Foundation (PFPSF) has been established to help bridge this gap. Patient Safety is at the heart of the mission of PFPSF, a non-profit organization, sponsored by CAHO. The objective is to raise awareness of avoidable medical harm, and make them participate actively in their own care. Our three key focus areas and strategic action plans are:

- Educate: educating patients, families and the public about patient safety by sharing best practices aggregated from experts, hospitals, doctors, researchers and international experiences in clinical domains through an extensive outreach program
- Empower: Make patients aware about their rights and responsibilities, encourage them to ask questions, and make informed decisions about their health.
- Engage: Patients can contribute to their own safe care, along with healthcare providers, by sharing experiences, feedback and suggestions. Thereby creating a partnership with care providers.





PFPS 's website www.patientsforpatientsafety.in contains credible knowledge via a Resource Centre, answers questions in the FAQs, and guides a person through a safe Patient Journey starting from symptoms, diagnosis, treatment options, following treatment and medication earnestly and post care guidelines. We aggregate this information from renowned global experts and healthcare providers. Simultaneously we are advocating a patient safety culture in hospitals with the active presence of patients as stakeholders.

Over 400 hospitals and diagnostic clinics have shown positive response to our request to become Hospital Safety Champions. There is need in their hospitals to become patient centric and encourage patient involvement. It will be good for health care organizations to establish patient advisory groups and where possible have a dedicated chief patient officer who represent patient's voice on the high table. PFPSF will assist bring these linkages.

World Patient Safety Day 2022

MEDICATION SAFETY

World Patient Safety Day is an important global event to improve Global patient safety challenge action plan 2021-2030. To commemorate World Patient Safety Day and promotion of the theme of WHO's WPSD 2022 - Medication Safety: Medication Without Harm, CAHO organized various activities over a month commencing from August 2022 and concluding on 17th September 2022.

Pledge to Promote Medication Safety

A national campaign (#PledgeForMedicationSafety) to promote medication without harm by taking a "pledge" was launched. This initiative sensitized all the stakeholders about the safe use of medications and their responsibilities. This voluntary process of pledging to adopt Medication Safety Practices was taken up by 69685 individuals (1648 doctors, 8036 nurses, 883 pharmacists and 59,118 others including patients).

E-Quiz Competition

A national-level quiz competition on medication safety was organized. 251 teams from various organizations across the country participated. We also had 6 teams participating from the Middle East. Each team had 3 participants comprising a doctor, nurse, and pharmacist. It was conducted in four levels. Level 1 & 2 screening was done on the online platform using Google forms. Top 50 teams progressed to level 2. Out of the 50,15 teams were shortlisted for Level 3 which was on the KAHOOT platform. The grand finale of the competition "Kaun Banega Gyanpati" was held live in which 5 teams competed with each other and winners with top scores were declared and awarded. It was attended by 370+ delegates.

Continuing Quality Education (CQE) Series

CQE Series is an initiative by the Quality Professionals division of CAHO in collaboration with ASQua. The theme of the August Series was - Medication Safety. It had informative discussions by eminent speakers covering various topics like pharmaceutical supply chain management, rational prescription , role of pharmacies, antibiotics stewardship implementation, pharmacovigilance, quality indicators etc. The program was attended by 313 participants with great feedback

Certificate Program in Medication Safety

A 2 -days online Certificate Program on Medication Safety was launched. The program had a defined curriculum. The sessions were interspersed with discussions on procurement, storage, prescription dispensing, and administration. The proactive risk reduction, medication errors, patient education tools, and stewardship programs were also part of the program.

Webinars

Three webinars were also organized on the theme Medication Without Harm. In an institutional webinar, a panel of eminent speakers from the medical fraternity elucidated the challenges and opportunities for healthcare professionals and the role of citizens in promoting medication safety. The webinar conducted for industry highlighted the environmental impact of the challenge and the role of green chemistry in exploring sustainable and healthy living. A panel discussion on Medication Without Harm - Where the Buck Stops was also conducted by CAHO North Zone.

We had also partnered with various other organizations in webinars on WPSD 2022 theme.



Publicity Materials

Various publicity materials on medication safety and safe medication practices in hospitals including posters, animated video jingles were created and made available for hospitals and general public to promote at large.

A special podcast on WPSD theme - Medication Safety was also created on CAHO's PODCAST Channel.

National Certifying Exam For Infection Control Professionals

The Consortium of Accredited Health Care Organizations (CAHO) in India launched a National-Level Certification Exam for Infection Control Professionals (ICPs) to recognize the competence of professionals who implement necessary precautions to limit the spread of infectious agents. This is the first of its kind in India and is comparable with international standards.

To prepare 105 candidates for the exam, an online crash course was conducted from December 2022 to March 2023. The course covered the exam syllabus, basics of microbiology and epidemiology, patient and workplace safety, and infection control practices in a health care setting. Renowned faculties in the field of infection control, including Dr. Aruna Poojary, Dr. J Jayalakshmi, Dr. Deepthi Madhu, and Dr. Malathi M., conducted the course.

The Certification in Infection Prevention and Control (CIPC) highlights an individual's commitment to best practices in IPC and improved patient care, as well as their dedication to professional growth. The examination was meticulously planned in accordance with international standards by Dr. Malathi M. (Program director) under the guidance of Dr. Lallu Joseph (Secretary General, CAHO) and Dr. Vijay Agarwal (President, CAHO).

The Consortium of Accredited Health Care Organizations (CAHO) in India launched a National-Level Certification Exam for Infection The CICP examination was conducted on March 12, 2023, through an online proctored mode of examination with a highly secured and vigilant portal. The examination questions were screened by a board of reviewers and standardized with a difficulty scoring index. Out of the 105 candidates who registered for the exam, 75 successfully cleared the examination, and seven candidates (three medical and three nursing) won gold, silver, and bronze medals based on a grade of more than 75%.

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, infection prevention and control practices have become increasingly vital. Health care-associated infections continue to pose a significant threat in India, resulting in increased morbidity and mortality across the healthcare system. CAHO's initiative to recognize and certify the competence of IPC professionals is crucial in ensuring the proper implementation of necessary precautions to limit the spread of infectious agents.

CAHO intends to conduct the next IPC examination in October 2023. Stay tuned for the CAHO Friday Updates for more information on this and other CAHO initiatives.
