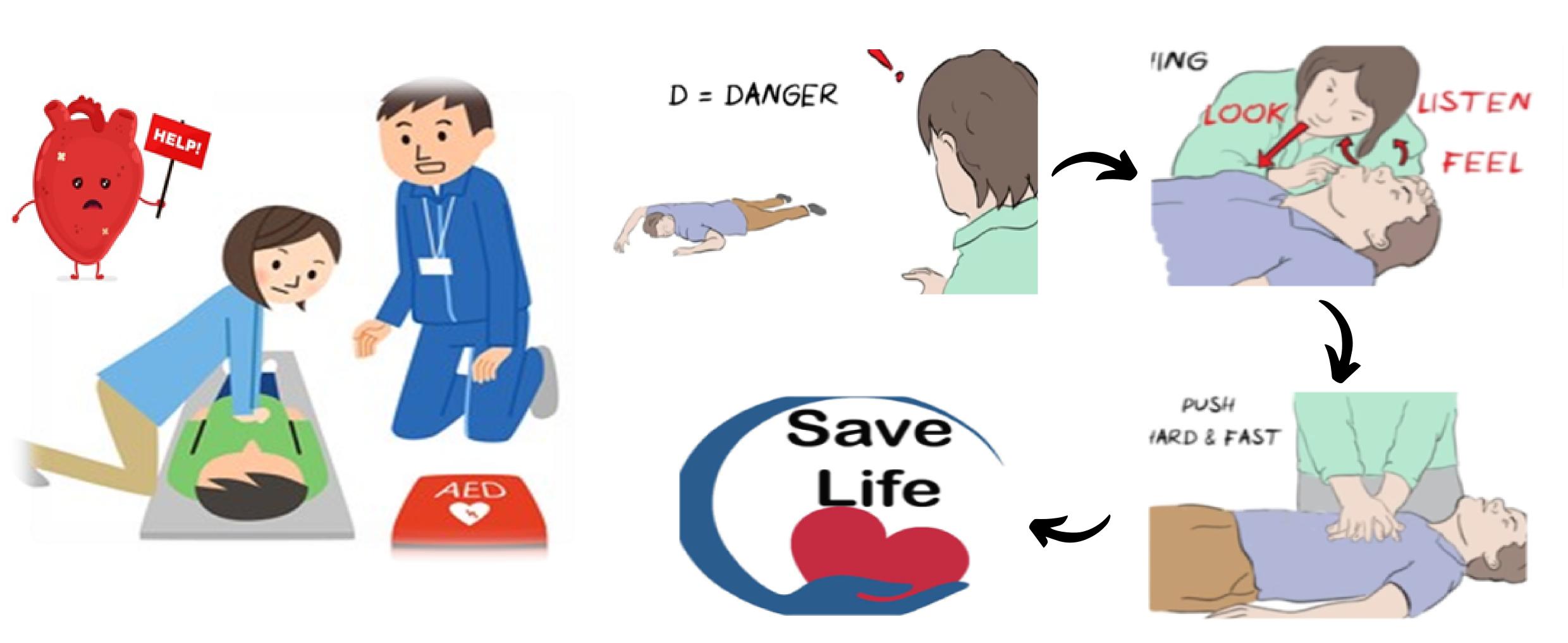
Empower and train society to deal with an emergency situation for greater chance of survival.

- Learning the CPR can be empowering you to save millions of life.





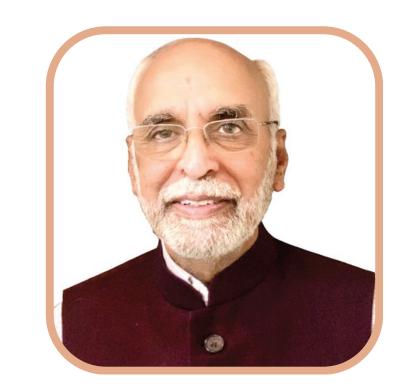


CPR TRAINING DRIVE
