Aim

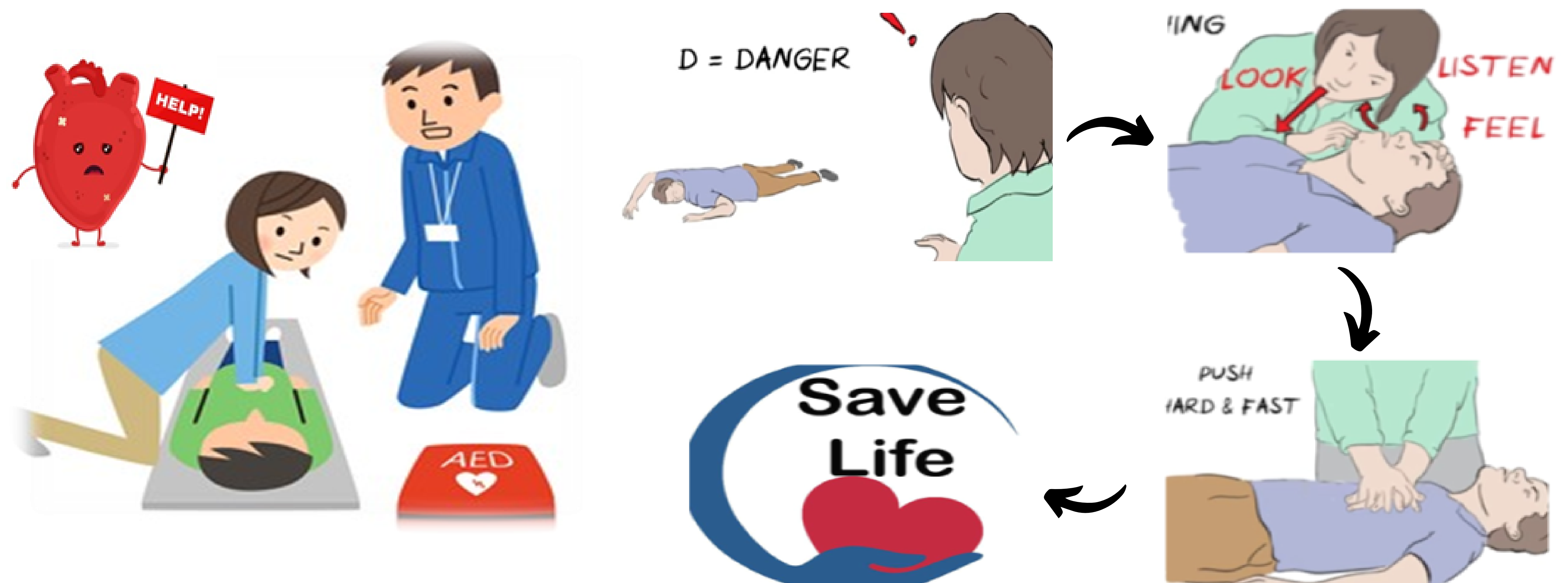
Empower and train society to deal with an emergency situation for greater chance of survival.
